Yet, on a ship's manifest, his middle name is listed as Franklin. We assume that his middle name is Frederick, although he may have used another name at one time. His son Roland is listed on a census, so we feel that link is accurate. In addition, William is listed on the census for his father, George.

On the Baltic ship's manifest, he is listed as being 30 years old and a married male coming from Skoffa Loka, Slovenia. He had a ticket for Pueblo, CO, for which he paid himself. He had \$32 and it was his first time in the United States. He was coming to see a friend in the U.S. by the name of Gaber Johann, at 7213 Bohimen Ave. in Pueblo, CO. He is listed on the manifest as Andrey Kaisar.)

On the La Provence from Havre, it indicates he resided in Krain, Slovenia. He came to the U.S. with \$25 to Pueblo Co., CO, to see a friend named Andreas Yagic in Heaton, NM.

Baptisms from the Westfield Presbyterian Church, Westfield, New Jersey from 1818 to 1828 are missing. It has been rumored that the pastor at that time, who was from Scotland, may have taken these records back with him to that country.

From Homestead papers: 14 X 24 foot house built in November, 1895. All fenced and cross fenced. 75 acres in cultivation. Hen house. Orchard. Cistern. Hog lots. Value \$300. "In 1896 I broke 20 acres and have added thereto until I now cultivate 75 acres. Have raised crops 7 seasons." (This homestead was 160 acres and the cost to Asa was \$14.)

There is very little evidence of the lineage of Asa D. Littell and his father William Terry Littell. What evidence we do have is found in the book "Family Records or Genealogies of the First Settlers of Passaic Valley." According to the Westfield Presbyterian Church in NJ, William Littell and Sarah Dunham were married in 1817. Having a child in 1818 would be common. It is further evidence that Asa is William's son. The will of Joseph B. Dunham lists Asa and his sister Mary Eliza as heirs.

Baptisms from the Westfield Presbyterian Church, Westfield, New Jersey from 1818 to 1828 are missing. It has been rumored that the pastor at that time, who was from Scotland, may have taken these records back with him to that country.

There is very little evidence of the lineage of Asa D. Littell and his father William Terry Littell. What evidence we do have is found in the book "Family Records or Genealogies of the First Settlers of Passaic Valley." According to the Westfield Presbyterian Church in NJ, William Littell and Sarah Dunham were married in 1817. Having a child in 1818 would be common. It is further evidence that Asa is William's son. The will of Joseph B. Dunham lists Asa and his sister Mary Eliza as heirs.

Researcher Phyllis glimpsed the following from the **Bourbon Co., KY Marriage Returns 1786-1801**:

Cornelius Sealy and Elizabeth Littell, May 19, 1789, married by Richard Durrett, page 2.

Crystal Dinger of the KYGenWeb Bourbon Co. site (<http://kykinfolk.com/bourbon>) tells me that other researchers have referred to him as Cornelius Sooly and her as Elizabeth Little or Littrell (a not uncommon dilemma). However, it is quite clear from the scan below that the names indeed appear to be Cornelius Sealy and Elizabeth Littell.

In that I cannot find this Elizabeth in the LFH&G volumes, I'm hoping a Kentucky researcher will be able to link us up to Cornelius and Elizabeth.

William Littell,

Author of the Littell Statutes

William Littell (1768-1824) Lawyer, legal scholar and satirist. Born in New Jersey and raised in Pennsylvania where tradition says he studied theology and medicine, William Littell joined the migration to the Kentucky frontier, presenting himself in 1799 for admission to the Fleming County bar. Littell soon threw himself into the political turmoil of the new commonwealth. A Jeffersonian, his literary skills were enlisted by leading Republicans in their struggle with the Federalists over their alleged involvement in the so-called Spanish Conspiracy. In ***Political Transactions in and Concerning Kentucky*** (1806), Littell used historical narrative to defend his party's leading figures from the charge of conspiring to align frontier Kentucky with Spain.

Littell's political connections no doubt helped him in 1805 to obtain a contract from the Kentucky legislature to publish a compilation of the state's statutes. In a letter to the Kentucky Gazette published when he was attempting to promote the work on a private subscription basis, Littell set out his political justification for such a publication, noting that "[t]here is no principle more truly republican than that the people who are amenable to the laws should know their import." The idea that the law should be public and readily accessible to those under its rule occurs often in his writings.

The finished work, ***The Statute Law in Kentucky*** (1809-1819), would eventually run to five volumes. "Littell's Statutes," as it would be known to generations of lawyers, was immediately recognized (even by the author's many critics) to be of the highest quality and it cemented Littell's reputation as a legal scholar. While compiling this massive work, he took time to write *Principles of Law and Equity* (1808), the first digest of Kentucky case law. Littell continued his work on Kentucky legislation with *Digest of Statute Law* (1822) compiled with the help of his protégé Jacob Swigert. He also published five volumes of reports along with a single volume of older unpublished decisions. In 1810, Littell's legal scholarship was recognized when Transylvania University, the leading institution of higher learning in the Western frontier, granted him the L.L.D.

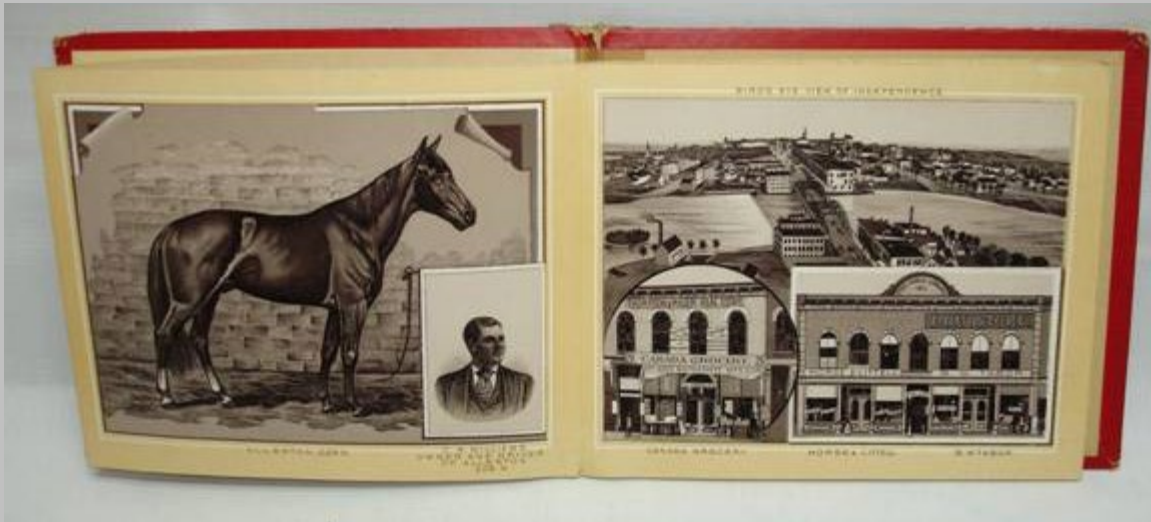
It is as a bitter satirist of the politics and mores of the frontier that Littell has interested literary historians, but it is important to note that even his humorous writings were inspired by the law. In his first satiric work, ***The Epistles of William Surnamed Littell*** (1806), later reprinted as part of ***Festoons of Fancy*** (1816), he lampooned Federalist supporters of state banking interests, offered support for a divorce law, and recounted his efforts to convince the state to support the publication of its statutes. Along the way he tweaked the slaveocracy for sleeping with their slaves and skewered the avarice of the "merchants of Lexington."

It is perhaps not surprising that tradition records that Littell was not a well-liked man. Some biographical treatments are decidedly hostile, one impugning his morality while ridiculing his physical appearance. In a new frontier society desperately trying to rise to respectability, a satiric eye is not usually welcomed. Littell was not without friends; reportedly penniless when he died in 1824, the state legislature passed a law for the relief of his family.

In 1939, Norman Littell accepted President Franklin D. Roosevelt's request to take on the position of assistant attorney general. His duties involved supervising land acquisition. After a while, he became very vocal about anti-trust business affairs and was fired by FDR in 1944.

Norman Littell wrote two books about his life experiences, *Trails of the Sea* and *My Roosevelt Years*.

Samuel Squier Littell & Benjamin F. Littell

of Cincinnati – Looking for Relativity

As noted in the introduction of Chapter 12 of Littell Families History & Genealogy, there is more detective work to be done establishing the Benjamin F. Littell line.

An early history of Decatur Co., IN indicates that Benjamin F. Littell was born in VT and that he moved to Cincinnati, OH. The city directory lists his occupation as brick maker, living on Fifth Street. (His birth is estimated ca. 1780 and death ca. 1824 “during a cholera epidemic.”) He married Elizabeth Perkin Merrill and had Benjamin Franklin Littell (b. 1820 Cincinnati), Elizabeth, Sarah Ann and Clara.

Researcher Judy poses the question: could Benjamin F. of VT be a brother to Samuel Squier Littell (1786-1825), a contractor also living in Cincinnati? Records mention that Samuel’s father also lived there, but no name for him has been established. Could it be that Samuel and Benjamin are first cousins?

Judy has compiled this lineage for Samuel Squier Littell. (She also wonders if perhaps Samuel’s father could be William Meeker Littell due to the naming pattern of his children.)
